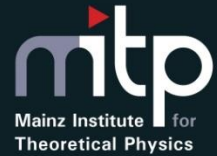


Supergravity and Holography

Description:

The aim is to bring together researchers with expertise in supergravity models, geometric approaches to theories of gravity and holography techniques, to explore in detail (and, possibly, overcome) the frontiers of the gauge/gravity duality and its applications under the gravitational perspective, in a fruitful collaborative environment. The possibility of connecting and discussing with other fellow colleagues is a vital aspect of research, endangered by the current pandemic. SUGRHOW-21 will be of international reach, bringing together supergravity and holography experts from various universities all over the world. The event will take place daily from 3:00 pm to 6:30 pm CET, to allow participation from many time zones. Besides two plenary talks, we plan, for each day, a final one-hour discussion session.
